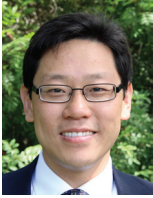

January 10, 2019

**Benedict Nguyen** is the Chancellor and Promoter of Justice for the Diocese of Corpus Christi, Texas.



February 14, 2019

**Greg and Julie Alexander** rebounded from the brink of divorce 18 years ago and since then have been helping thousands of couple prepare, enrich and heal from their troubled marriages. They've created a nonprofit, hosted a radio show, 3 ETWN series and traveled the world presenting the various aspects of marriage.



March 7, 2019

**John Horvat II** is a scholar, researcher, educator, international speaker, and author. For more than two decades he has been researching and writing about what's gone wrong with America's culture and economy, an effort that culminated in the ground-breaking release of his award-winning book *Return to Order: From a Frenzied Economy to an Organic Christian Society—Where We've Been, How We Got Here and Where We Need to Go*.



April 11, 2019

May 9, 2019

**Nicole Havrilla** is the President & Founder of WholeLife Authentic Care, a non-profit medical clinic that is focused on offering NaProTECHNOLOGY, a unique pro-life approach to healthcare for women and families. She is responsible for the daily efforts of the project, while raising \$1.3 million dollars. WholeLife is projected to open summer 2019



June 13, 2019

**Fr. Dennis McManus** has taught at Georgetown University since 1997. He holds a master's degree in historical ethics from Georgetown University and a doctorate from Drew University in historical theology.

McManus has served for the last four years as Consultant for Jewish Affairs at the USCCB, where he staffs the two official dialogues between the Jewish community and the Catholic Church in the United States.



July 11, 2019

**Janet Morana** serves as the Co-Founder of the Silent No More Awareness Campaign, the world's largest mobilization of women and men who have lost children to abortion.



August 8, 2019

**Fr. Dwight Longenecker**, originally from PA, studied theology at Oxford University and was ordained as an Anglican priest and served as a school chaplain in Cambridge and a country parson on the Isle of Wight. Realizing that the Anglican Church and I were on divergent paths, he and his family were received into the Catholic Church in 1995. His family continued to live in England until 2006 when the door opened to return to the US and be ordained a Catholic priest. He currently serves as Pastor of Our Lady of the Rosary Church in Greenville, South Carolina.



September 12, 2019

**Thomas McKenna** is the founder and President of Catholic Action for Faith and Family, an association of Catholics that strives to uphold and defend Christian values inspired by the teachings of the Roman Catholic Church and aims to provide a network of resources and activities for clergy and laity to inspire them to reach out to others in an active way to defend these values.



October 10, 2019

**John Garvey** is the President of The Catholic University of America. He was dean of Boston College Law School from 1999 to 2010. In 2008, he was the President of the Association of American Law Schools. He has practiced law and taught at Notre Dame, Michigan, and Kentucky. From 1981 to 1984 he was Assistant to the Solicitor General of the United States.



November 14, 2019

**Fr. Ambrose Criste** is a Rhodes Scholar who attended Oxford University before receiving the call to religious life as Norbertine priest of St. Michael's Abbey.
