The Rev. Paul Chaim Benedicta Schenck BA, MA, EdD, LHD.

Fr. Schenck is a priest of the Diocese of Harrisburg where he is Director of Respect Life Activities. He originally attended a missionary bible college, an Evangelical seminary and Catholic University. He was ordained in the Evangelical Anglican tradition. He and his family united with the Catholic Church in 2004. While a Protestant minister in western New York, Fr. Schenck challenged a federal court order prohibiting pro-life activities. Convicted of violating the order for distributing bibles, leading prayers and sidewalk counseling on public sidewalks, he was sentenced to two years in federal prison. His case, Rev. Schenck V Pro-Choice, reached the United States Supreme Court which ruled 8-1 in his favor striking down the order as a violation of the First Amendment of the Constitution.

**Most Reverend Charles J. Chaput,
O.F.M. Cap., D.D. Archbishop of
Philadelphia**

This will be a joint meeting between the Bucks County, Philadelphia and Lehigh Valley Chapters.

Archbishop Charles J. Chaput was born September 26, 1944, in Concordia, Kansas, the son of Joseph and Marian DeMarais Chaput. He joined the Order of Friars Minor Capuchin, St. Augustine Province, in 1965. After earning a Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy from St. Fidelis College Seminary in Herman, Pennsylvania, in 1967, Archbishop Chaput completed Studies in Theology at Catholic University in Washington D.C., in 1969. He earned a Master of Arts in Religious Education from Capuchin College in Washington D.C., in 1970 and was ordained to the priesthood on August 29, 1970. Archbishop Chaput was ordained Bishop of Rapid City, South Dakota, on July 26, 1988. Pope John Paul II appointed him Archbishop of Denver on February 18, 1997, and he was installed on April 7th the same year. As a member of the Prairie Band Potawatomi Tribe, Archbishop Chaput was the second Native American to be ordained a bishop in the United States, and the first Native American Archbishop. He was installed as the 13th Bishop and ninth Archbishop of Philadelphia on September 8, 2011.

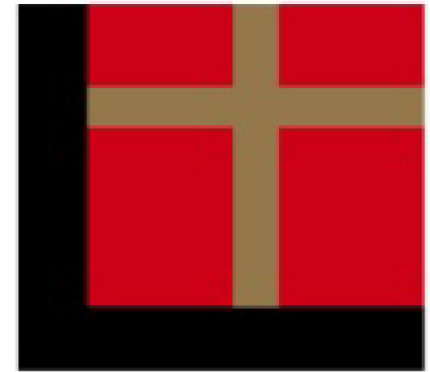
